Main Achievements /Activities since AGM 2016

March 2016

- New toilets were fitted in both the men's and ladies' cubicles and new waterless urinals fitted to reduce costs. All toilet areas were painted to give a much fresher cleaner look. This work was undertaken as part of the ongoing mainence program and as a savings measure

April 2016

- After a successful Race night on April 23rd, 2016 with 72 attending Glatton village hall made a profit of £1136, it was therefore decided to hold the event again on 29th April 2017.

June 2016

- The village hall in conjunction with the church held a village fun day on June 18th in the grounds of St Georges' nursing home, the event was very successful and attracted large numbers with the sun being kind to us. The added fun events and dog show were very popular. The fun day profit was split with the church and GVH netted £602.00.

November 2016

- No Halloween event was held this year after a poor turnout last year.

- The floor in the main hall had become unsafe with various boards either splintering or nails sticking up. It was decided to fit new flooring on top of the existing flooring at a cost of £3896. The floor still needs to be finished off in places once the flooring has had time to settle. Our thanks to Steve Smith who funded the labour costs.

The Santa event in 2014 made a loss and did not attract much support from the children of the village so it was decided not to hold the event in 2016. The village hall funds do not allow us to cover such events with ongoing maintenance costs of the hall ever increasing.
