Updated Coronavirus guidance

The Church of England has issued new guidance in response to the coronavirus pandemic. At present we will continue to gather in worship, in study and in pray. If this changes we will inform you as soon as we are able. If you self-isolate for any reason please let Rev. Becky know so we can ensure we are able to offer you pastoral and spiritual support.

Here are some key details you need to be aware of:

- For the time being all communicants will receive of 'one kind' and only the priest will drink from the chalice.
- Please stand at the communion rail (Do not kneel or touch the communion rail).
- During the peace no physical contact will be made.
- There will also be no physical contact as part of a blessing at the communion rail.
- We ask everyone to refrain from handshaking and using other physical contact greetings.
- Please continue to make use of taps in church to wash hands and make regular use of hand sanitizer.
